



OPEN EUROPEAN MASSAGE CHAMPIONSHIP

The National SPA association invites you to participate in the Open European Massage Championship!

The National SPA association has been organizing massage championships in Lithuania since 2007. In 2015 Panevežys college has joined this initiative, which proved to be a great synergy. This year we expect to welcome a record number of 30 participants from different European countries who will take part in Open European Massage Championship.

Why should I participate?

- **Valuable prizes for winners and all other participants** (first place holder will receive 1.000 EUR, second place – 500 EUR, third place – 300 EUR; weekends in luxurious SPAs, different SPA techniques training; product kits from sponsors and other valuable goodies).
- **Various nominations** - “The innovator of the year”, “The most authentic SPA surroundings”, etc.
- **Every participant receives a diploma.**
- **Transparent 7-person jury panel.** The jury team will consist of field experts from at least 4 countries.
- **An opportunity to spend 2 days with the best massage specialists** from Lithuania, Latvia, Belarus, Estonia, Moldova, Greece, Ukraine, Poland, Italy and other countries and to share your experience.
- **The championship will take place in an exquisite 5 star hotel “Vanagupė” in a beautiful Lithuanian resort Palanga, on the cost of the Baltic sea**, so work and leisure will go along easily.
- **Special relaxation** treat for the participants, which will take place on the first night.
- **Cosy championship closure buffet**, where you will share your event experiences as well as rejoice your winnings amongst your peers (the buffet is included in the entry fee).

The championship will take place in two days:

- 1st day - the theory exam and the classical massage;
- 2nd day - freestyle programme with the SPA concept.

Participation requirements:

The participant should have at least two years (uninterrupted) of practical masseur's experience (medical education is not required) and/or hold an undergraduate diploma in Biomedicine science (practical experience not required in this case).

Participant registration:

- Participants should register to the Open European Massage Championship by sending their applications to the following e-mail: aira@spalietuva.lt. The registration is open from **18th of February 2016** to **4th of May 2016**.
- Documents required for participation should be sent along with the registration form to aira@spalietuva.lt
- **Early registration fee is 169 EUR**, which has to be paid to National Spa Association before the 8th of April 2016.
- **Registration fee is 189 EUR**, if be paid to National Spa Association after the 8th of April 2016.
- **Registration fee for members of National Spa Association is 139 EUR.**
- The following is **not included** in the registration fee: accommodation and meals (participant may choose to stay in 5-star hotel) single room with breakfast and access to water spa area – 35 EUR/per person/per night; double room with breakfast and access to water spa area – 45 EUR/per room/per night; additionally participants and their accompanying team may choose a special meal offer: lunch (soup, hot dish, a drink) – 6 EUR per person and supper (salad, hot dish, a drink) – 7 EUR per person. The prices listed are applicable **only** during the participant's stay from 17th of May to 20th of May 2016. For other dates the standard hotel pricing applies.
- Registration is only approved after receiving the confirmation of the application and paying the registration fee.
